... The story takes place over a whole year—it starts in spring, goes through summer, autumn and winter, and finishes in spring again. The author wrote about the seasons to show what would happen in the long run.

**Make Inferences**

The birds in this story only arrive in the town in spring. What does this tell you about the birds, and the weather in the town? ○○○

**Characters**

The characters are the people or animals in a story. What does the man who loves birds say when the farmers decide to get rid of them? How would you describe him? ○○○

**Cause and Effect**

What happens at Killingworth after the farmers chase the birds away? Why do these things happen? ○○○

... In summer, there are no birds to eat the insects. The insects eat all the leaves on every tree so there is no shade for the people. The insects also eat the crops and fruits, so there isn't much for the people to harvest. That means there isn't much food in autumn and winter for the people to eat.

**ORGANISE INFORMATION**

**Problem and Solution**

### Reading Tips: fl

#### Before Reading

- Read aloud the title of the book. Have children use the title and the cover illustration to make predictions about what the story will be about.
- Introduce the *fl* sound. Explain to children that the letters *fl* are a blend that is used in words like *fly*. Write the word *fly* on the chalkboard and have a volunteer circle the letters *fl*. Go through the pronunciation of the word with the children. Ask them to suggest other words that contain the *fl* sound.
- Have children listen as you read the title again. Ask them to name all the words in the title that have the *fl* sound.
- Tell children that this book has lots of words with the *fl* sound and that the words are in boldface type. Skim the book with children and look for words containing the *fl* sound.
